

This rider is updated regularly and pursuant to Production Manager's advance. Please check that you have the latest version, and disregard any previously released versions or "word of mouth" information, other than information sent only by those authorized by Hot Potato Band.

1. Required Personnel:

HPB is a 10-piece band (of which I am one of them) and we try to keep our touring party to a minimum. Due to this the following personnel are required:

1. FOH Sound Engineer

- a. If the Bands FOH Engineer is to attend a show it will be advanced to the Venue/Festival by the tour manager and a request for the production spec will be made
- 2. Monitor Sound Engineer (if applicable)
- 3. Lighting Operator
 - a. If the Bands Lighting Designer is to attend a show it will be advanced to the Venue/Festival by the tour manager and a request for the house patch and plot will be made.
 - b. The LD's prefered console is GrandMA2 V3.5.0.6+

2. HPB's Monitoring/FOH System Requirements:

Monitor Wedges:

- (2) high quality monitor wedges
- (2) Drum Fill

In Ear Split:

Ideally a 3 way split is supplied in a festival setting so that we can drop in our rack system efficiently. If not then please read below:

- The drummers **DO NOT** use IEMs
- All other instruments do (Trombone, Trumpet, Alto, Tenor, Bari, Lead Vocal, Sousaphone).
- All lines (Including the house provided lines) must go via HPB's IEM Mixer so that we can mix them ourselves.
- HPB will provide an IEM Split for mixing the frontline IEMs. This includes a 16-way Split (2x Behringer MS8000), a Mixer (Presonus RM32AI), 1RU 16 x Output Patchbay, and a 2m 16-way XLR tails to give back to the house (if needed)

The following lines need to be provided from you and sent to our Split:

- **CH 1-8 House provided Drum/Perc Mics**. As HPB does not tour with Drum Mics, Mic Stands, and Cables, Inputs 1-8 are to be provided by the house. Please refer to the input list for more details.
- **CH 15 House provided Wireless Vocal Mic (for no extra cost).** As HPB does not tour a wireless vocal system, the house vocal wireless must be patched to the bands split system. *If a wireless mic cannot be provided then notify me in advance.*

1x 16-Channel Mixer Good quality P.A.

3. Microphones/Mic Stands (see input list for further detail):

The following is to be provided:

- 8x Drum Microphones
- 5x Tall boom microphone stands
- 5x Short boom microphone stands
- 1x Extra tall straight round-base microphone stand
- 1x Ambient mic (an SM57 is fine if no other alternative is available)

We have our own radio mics for Trombone, Trumpet, Alto Sax, Tenor Sax, Baritone Sax, & Sousaphone

4. HPB's Unique Backline Requirements:

Drums/Percussion (*Communicate to me in advance if it is a small stage/venue without a riser*)

The drum riser MUST be striked in order to set up the bands unique percussion line-up. Please prepare with mic stands and cables for the following:

Person 1 (Stage Right of Riser)

- 1. Snare
- 2. Hi-Hats
- 3. Overhead L (Ride and Crash Cymbals)

Person 2 (Stage Centre of Riser)

- 1. Bass Drum Left (Stage Right)
- 2. Bass Drum Right (Stage Left)

This is a bass drum mounted on an X-Stand with both left and right hands striking the instrument with heavy mallets. This will need two matched microphones for consistency of sound. Please refer to the input list for more details.

Person 3 (Stage Left of Riser)

- 1. Conga
- 2. Rack Tom
- 3. Overhead R (Shaker, Tambourine, Crash and Splash Cymbals)

Sousaphone

The Sousaphone is the band's "bass player" instrument. The house bass head and cab will be used.

5. Power:

3x Power drops on stage required (See stage Plot)

- 1. Power for Lead Vocal Effects Pedal
- 2. Power for Sousaphone Effects Pedal and Amp
- 3. Power for IEM Mixer/Split
